

About the Drawbridge

Guest Services The guest desk is in the main lobby. They have maps of area possibilities. The hotel also provides a complimentary airport shuttle service, free hotel parking, gift shop, hair limited, masseuse, and non-smoking & smoking rooms.

RV-Hook-UP If you're planning on attending and bringing your RV you need to contact the hotel before hand to make sure they have space available. There is a fee for parking if you wish to use to use the hotels electrical hookup.

Recreation Facilities Include Three swimming pools (one indoor). Basketball and volleyball courts, a fitness room with whirlpool & sauna. They also have a Video game room, with a pool table and children's play area.

Laundry Facilities There is a laundry facility on site where you can wash and dry your clothes Located in the Garrison Bldg.

Snacks and Things Dairy Queen: On site delicious ice cream & sandwiches hot and cold.

Citgo: Fuel and all your beverage needs; open 24 hours a day.

Crossbow Tavern: The hotels liveliest lounge and is located downstairs from the main lobby.

Something new at the Drawbridge

Hourly shuttle transportation provided by TANK (Transit Authority of Northern Kentucky) to Covington Landing and to Downtown Cincinnati (currently \$.75 charge).
